NEW BUSINESS

BALLOT ACCESS FOR AL

Bill Redpath and Laura Lane gave a presentation on the current ballot access status in Alabama.

BALLOT ACCESS FOR NY

Bill Redpath and John Phillips gave a presentation on the current ballot access status in New York.

WITHOUT OBJECTION, Phillips moved to amend the motion previously adopted to encumber \$30,000 for the New York ballot access drive to be paid out at a rate of up to \$6,000 per week for the 5 weeks of the drive to now read

"Move to encumber \$30,000 for the New York ballot access drive to be conditionally paid out on the following schedule.

-If the NY petition drive has collected at least 10,000 signatures, by the close of business on April 25th, 2022, the LNC pay out \$7,500 to the LPNY.

-If the NY petition drive has collected at least 20,000 signatures, by the close of business on May 2nd, 2022, the LNC pay out \$7,500 to the LPNY.

-If the NY petition drive has collected at least 30,000 signatures, by the close of business on May 9th, 2022, the LNC pay out \$7,500 to the LPNY.

-If the NY petition drive has collected at least 40,000 signatures, by the close of business on May 16th, 2022, the LNC pay out \$7,500 to the LPNY." [20220415-01]
